We have determined that each candidate is eligible (i.e., is a member) and have contacted all candidates; all have agreed to serve in the roles for which they have been identified, if elected by act of the Congregation.

**We were not successful in identifying an individual to serve as Secretary. However, we knew as we entered the search process that Kay Webb, the current Secretary, would agree to serve another year in that role. Kay's qualifications and record of performance in this role are impeccable.

We separate the nomination of Kay as Secretary from the nomination of the other candidates because the By-laws, at Section V.D.1.c (see Footnote), provide for only three consecutive terms of service for the office of the Secretary; Kay is finishing her third term at the end of this fiscal year.

Accordingly, we suggest two actions by the Congregation to address this issue:

First, move to suspend the By-laws at Section V.D.1.c, **for this meeting only,** and second, if the first motion carries, move to nominate Kay to serve a fourth term as Secretary.

Finally, we suggest that the Board consider recommending that the congregation revise the By-Laws as they relate to term limits for Officers and Members-at-Large. As these roles are defined at V.D.1.a and d, the offices of President-and Treasurer are limited to single one-year terms. Further, implicit in the creation of the offices of President-Elect and Treasurer-Elect, both defined as single year terms, is a succession plan that limits terms for these Offices to one year. We think there is good reason to limit terms for these offices, particularly for the role of Treasurer. However, we are not convinced that there are compelling reasons to limit either Members-at-Large or the Secretary from serving more than 3 terms.
